Step-by-Step Process to Challenge OJEE 2026 Answer Key:

Step 1: Visit the Official Website

Go to the official OJEE portal. Look for the link that says "Challenge Answer Key OJEE 2026".

Step 2: Login Using Credentials

Login with your:

- Application Number
- Date of Birth (format will be DDMMYYYY) / Password

This gives you access to your *response, question paper and Provisional Answer key.*

Step 3: Navigate to the Objection Section

Go to the "Candidate Response" tab to view question & answer and click on the "Objection Form" tab. Select the Subject/Course.

Step 4: View Question & Answer Key

The questions along with options and answers will appear on the screen also you will check your attempted options on same page.

Step 5: Review All Questions Carefully

Cross-check your responses with the provisional answers. Mark any question where you feel the answer is incorrect.

Step 6: Raise Objection

Select the question(s) you want to challenge on given question IDs. For each objection:

- **Select Question ID:** Choose the question ID from the dropdown menu that you wish to challenge.
- **Nature of Objection:** Select the reason for the objection (e.g., "Question is wrong," "Incorrect Option," "Multiple Options Correct").
- **Remarks:** Enter a clear justification for your objection in the text field.

Step 7: Proof/Document to be uploaded

- **Upload Supporting Documents:** Upload mandatory supporting documents (e.g., page from a standard textbook) to prove your challenge.
- **Format:** PDF, JPG, or JPEG.

Step 8: Pay the Challenge Fee

There is usually a non-refundable processing fee charged per question challenged. Make the payment online through the specified method (credit/debit card, net banking, UPI, etc.).

(The Challenge fee per question will be Rs.100/- (One Hundred Rupees Only). The Challenge fee will be refunded to those candidates only, whose challenge will be found acceptable after thorough review by OJEE Committee)

Step 9: Submit

After reviewing all the objections, submit your challenge. The system will generate a confirmation or receipt — save it for your future reference.

Step 10: Final Answer Key

After the objection window closes, OJEE committee will review all submitted challenges by taking subject expert committee. If your claim is found valid, the answer key will be corrected accordingly.

Important Tips Before Challenging the Answer Key

- Always check the official announcement for the date and time window to challenge — it's usually open for a limited period.
- Only challenge if you have a solid reason and valid proof — baseless objections are not accepted.
- Keep your login details and application number handy for quick access.
- Check that the supporting references you provide are from credible sources (like NCERT, official syllabus books, etc.).
- Understand the question numbering and paper set properly before raising any objection.
