

INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2nd ROUND COUNSELLING & ADMISSION TO MBBS/ BDS COURSES, 2025-26.

Before starting the registration for the 2nd round counselling process, all the candidates are advised to read carefully the “GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR COUNSELLING & ADMISSION TO MBBS/ BDS COURSES, 2025-26” available in the OJEE website.

All State Domicile NEET-UG 2025 qualified candidates or Outside State NEET-UG 2025 qualified candidates (eligible for NRI quota seats only), who has not registered in 1st round counselling are eligible for registration in 2nd Round Counselling.

Candidates who have completed their registration in the 1st Round need not required to register again. They can login using their credential created during registration in the 1st round and have to follow instructions there and they can fill or modify their choices.

All NRI candidates to upload the NRI documents as mentioned in the NRI notice published by MCC Ref: U-11011/07/2025-MEC, dated:02-09-2025

Instructions for Choice filling

In the 2nd Round Counselling two new colleges has been added to the previous list under MBBS course, for which all the registered candidates are allowed to modify their choices with bellow mentioned conditions.

- a) All the newly state merit listed candidates have to fill fresh choices without any conditions.
- b) Candidates allotted a seat in the previous round, exercised their option as FREEZE and completed the provisional admission after 1st round, if wishes to add or modify their choices, after login they have to give their consent, then their FREEZE option will be disabled and they will be able to add or modify their choice.
- c) Candidates allotted a seat in the previous round, exercised their option as FLOAT and completed the provisional admission after 1st round, if wishes to add or modify their choices, after login they have to give their consent, then they will be able to add or modify their choices.
(For above ‘b’ and ‘c’, it is to be noted here that any choice added below the choice that has been allotted in the 1st round is of no meaning as the allotment algorithm will not go below the allotted choice. Therefore, candidates are advised to fill or modify their choices judiciously.)
- d) Candidates have allotted a seat in the previous round and not reported for provisional admission will be out of the system and not considered in the 2nd round allotment process. However, if such candidate wishes to participate again in the 2nd round have to login, give consent and fill or modify their choices. **Therefore, such candidates mandatorily have to make login, give consent and fill choices for consideration in the 2nd round allotment process.**
- e) Candidates have not been allotted any seat in the 1st round have to login, give consent and may fill or modify their choices. If any candidate only does the login and gives consent and not modifies his/her choice, then 1st round choice filled by the candidate will be considered in the 2nd round allotment process.

All the provisionally admitted candidates to be noted that they must fill or modify their choices judiciously as after allotment they have to accept the new allotment in the 2nd round and the previously allotted seat will be automatically withdrawn and will be allotted to any other candidate as per the merit list.
