NOTICE FOR CANDIDATES WISH TO TAKE PART IN THE 85% STATE QUOTA MBBS/BDS (2nd Round) COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION PROCESS

It is for information of all registered/state merit listed candidates wish to take admission in the 85% State Quota MBBS/BDS (2nd round) counselling that, only the following criteria candidates can/have to fill/modify their choice in order to get a seat allotment as per their state rank & availability of seats.

Criteria to Fill/Modify Choices to get a Seat Allotment:

1. The candidates who have not allotted any seat in 1st round have to give a consent as “Yes” in order to fill/modify as per their choices in 2nd round.
2. The candidates who have allotted in 1st round but not physically report, they have to fill fresh choice as their previous choices will be treat as null & void.
3. The candidates who have withdrawn from counselling process due to any reason & wants to participate again in 2nd Round then they can fill fresh their choices by giving a consent as “Yes”.
4. The newly registered candidates in 2nd round have to fill choices as per the availability of seats & as per the schedule.

NB: The candidates allotted a seat in 1st round & physically reported at OJEE Office, Gandamunda cannot modify/fill any choices in any further rounds of web counselling.

Similarly, Candidates allotted a seat in 1st Round & not physically reported at OJEE Office, Gandamunda will be considered as Non-Reported candidates. They will not be considered in further rounds of counselling.

However, if a Non-Reported candidates want to participate again, then he/she have to give a consent as “Yes” to fill fresh choice in order to get a seat allotment in subsequent rounds.
