ELIGIBILITY:

1. Candidates interested to participate in the BAMS/BHMS counselling must have qualified, with valid rank, in NEET (UG)-2020.

(As per Letter No. F.No. R.14011/2/2021-EP-I dated 15.01.2021 of the Ministry of AYUSH, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks at 40th percentile in NEET-2020. However, in respect of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 30th percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 35th percentile for Un-Reserved (UR) Category and 30th percentile for SC/ST/OBC).

2. The candidates must be of at least **17 years** of age as on **31.12.2020**.

3. The parents of the candidates must be permanent natives of Odisha. Every candidate has to upload **Resident / Nativity certificate** during certificate verification.

4. The candidates must have passed +2 Sc. and in the subjects of **Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English** individually and must have secured minimum of 50% marks taken together in **Physics, Chemistry & Biology** at +2 Sc. level for General Candidate (GE). This minimum mark is 40% for SC/ST candidates.

Only the Candidates who have duly registered and filled their choices will be considered for Selection/Admission.

PAYMENT OF FEES :

1. During registration, candidates have to pay registration fee of **Rs.1000/- online**.
2. Allotted candidates have to deposit a part admission fee of **Rs.5000/- online** in the web portal.
